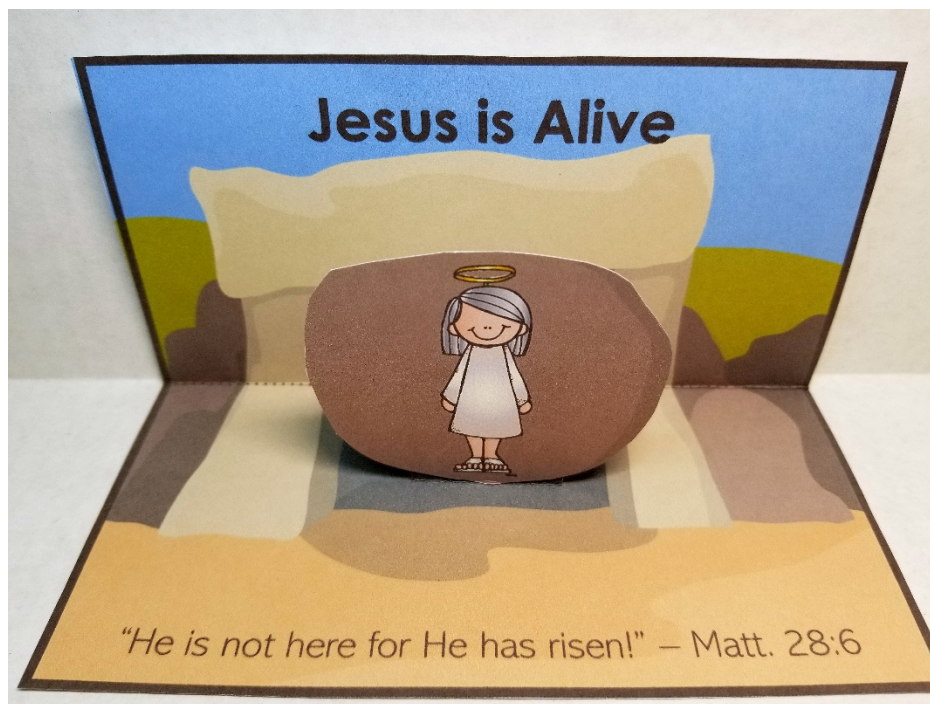


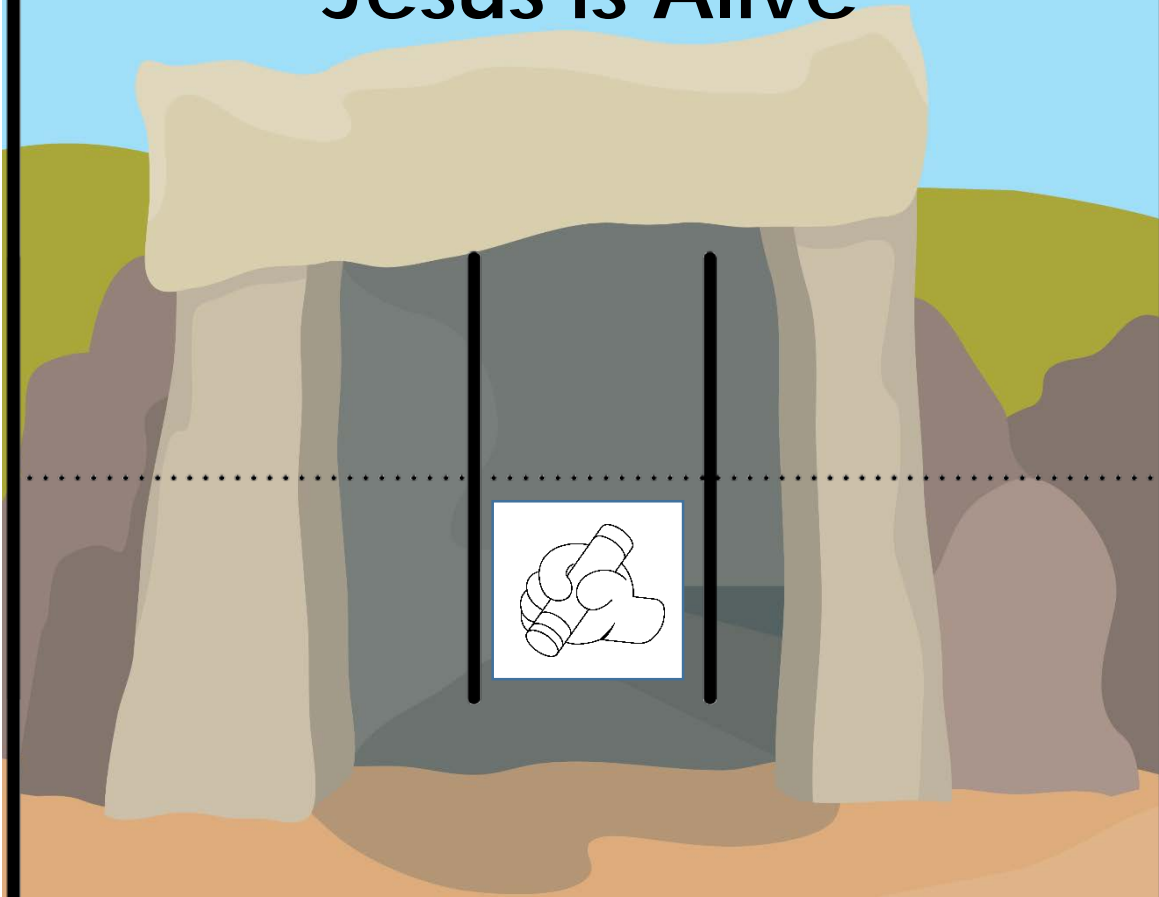
# Pop-Up Card

## The Easter Story



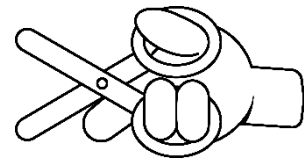

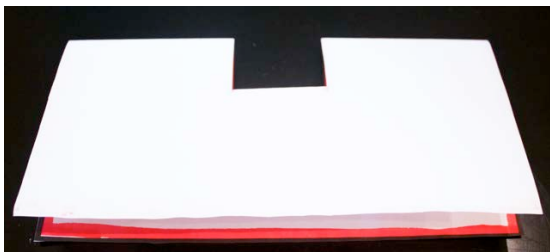
## Directions for Pop-Up Card



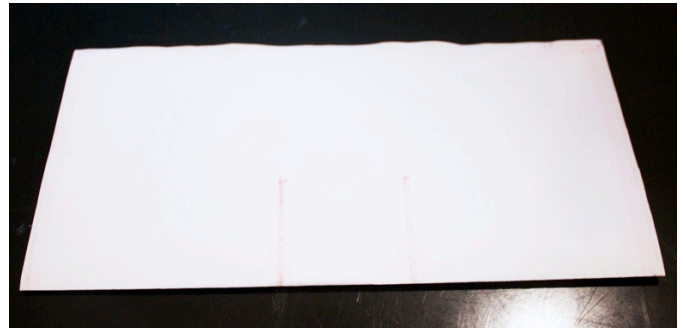
1. Cut on the outer solid lines.



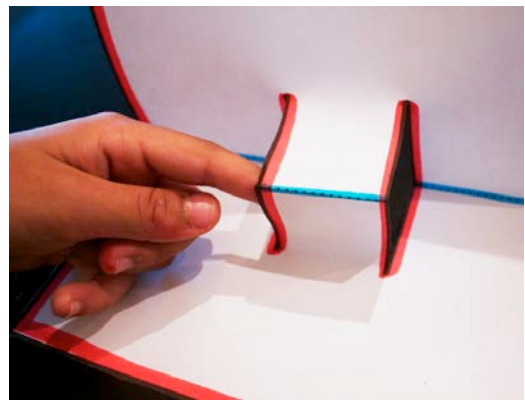
3. Cut on the solid lines. If you can not see through the paper to see the lines to cut, you can **fold the paper inside out in order to see the lines while cutting.**



5. Refold the paper in half. Make sure the pop-up part is tucked inside. Press on the paper where the pop-up part is to make creases.



2. Fold in half on the dotted line.



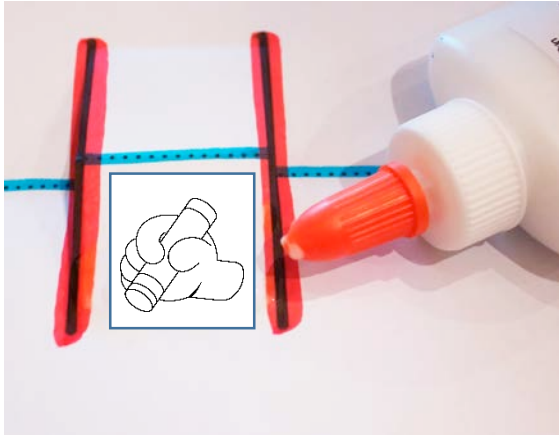
4. Open up the paper and pull the pop-up part(s) forward with your finger. Press and crease on the dotted line(s) to make the fold on the pop-up part go forward.



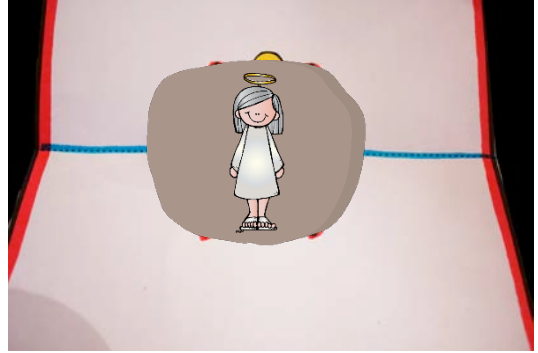
6. Cut out the shape or shapes You will be attaching to the pop-up.



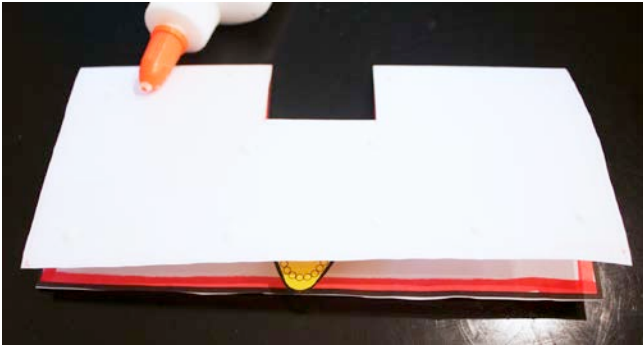
## Directions for Pop-Up Card



7. Dot glue on the pop-up part below the dotted line.



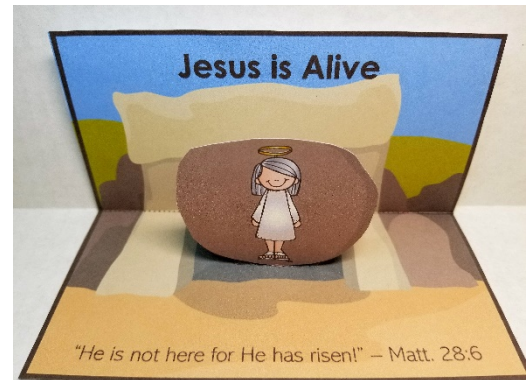
8. Attach the shape(s) to the pop-up part below the dotted line.



9. Dot glue on the outside top of the pop-up card.



10. Glue front of card on top.
